MOTION TO SUPPLEMENT THE RECORD

Aurelius Capital Management, LP, Fir Tree, Inc., King Street Capital, L.P., King Street Capital Master Fund, Ltd., Monarch Alternative Capital LP, and Stonehill Capital Management LLC (collectively, the "RMBS Policyholders"), the Federal National Mortgage Association ("Fannie Mae"), and the Federal Home Loan Mortgage Corporation ("Freddie Mac"), by their attorneys, shall and hereby move the Court to supplement the record pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 809.14 and

809.15 with the transcript of the November 30, 2010 closing arguments from the Circuit Court proceedings in this case. Attached is a true copy of that transcript.

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 809.15(13), transcripts of proceedings are considered part of the record on appeal. Accordingly, this court routinely considers transcripts of closing argument as evidence of what occurred during circuit court proceedings. *See, e.g, Grice Eng'g, Inc. v. Szyjewski*, 2002 WI App 104, ¶ 4, 254 Wis. 2d 743, 648N.W.2d 487.

Fannie Mae and the RMBS Policyholders each filed a Statement on Transcript in connection with the above-captioned appeal in which they indicated that "all transcripts for this appeal appear to already be on file in the Dane County Circuit Court." See Fannie Mae's Statement on Transcript, In re: Segregated Account of Ambac Assurance Corporation, Case No. 2010-cv-1576 (Dane County Cir. Ct. Mar. 10, 2011); RMBS Policyholders Statement on Transcript, In re: Segregated Account of Ambac Assurance Corporation, Case No. 2010-cv-1576 (Dane County Cir. Ct. Mar. 10, 2011); see generally Wis. Stat. § 809.11(4). However, it has recently come to the movants' attention that the November 30, 2010 hearing transcript – which was prepared and circulated to participants shortly after the hearing date – was not actually in the record that the Circuit Court transmitted to this Court.

The November 30, 2010 hearing transcript should be included in the appellate record so that this Court has a complete record of the proceedings that led to the Circuit Court's confirmation of the Rehabilitation Plan. The November

30, 2010 transcript should also be included because it will allow parties to demonstrate that they properly raised and preserved issues in the Circuit Court for this appeal.

Therefore, the movants respectfully request that the Court grant this Motion and direct the clerk to include the attached transcript in the record transmitted to the Court of Appeals in Appeal No. 2011 AP 561. To avoid any delay arising from this request, the movants waive their right to have any portion of these proceedings tolled pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 809.14 in connection with this Motion.
