I am one of the attorneys representing One State Street LLC, appellant in the above referenced appeals. This letter updates the Court regarding One State Street's settlement and responds to this Court's March 16, 2011 order regarding the many appeals stemming from Dane County Circuit Court Case No. 10-CV-1576, *In the Matter of the Rehabilitation of Segregated Account of Ambac Assurance Corporation*.


On March 1, 2011, One State Street entered into a settlement agreement (the "Settlement Agreement") with Ambac Assurance Corporation ("Ambac"), Ambac Financial Group, Inc, and the Segregated Account of Ambac, a copy of which is available for public inspection on www.ambacpolicyholders.com. The Dane County Circuit Court and the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York granted motions approving the Settlement Agreement on March 21, 2011 and March 24, 2011, respectively. Certain conditions to the effectiveness of the Settlement Agreement remain outstanding. One State Street anticipates that the effective date of the Settlement Agreement will occur prior to the proposed deadlines for filing appellant briefs in these proceedings.

Until the remaining conditions to the effectiveness of the Settlement Agreement are satisfied, however, One State Street will preserve its rights to prosecute the above referenced appeals. To that end, One State Street joins in the Proposed Order Regarding
