**MOTION TO DISSOLVE STATE COURT “ORDER FOR TEMPORARY  
SUPPLEMENTAL INJUNCTIVE RELIEF” AND  
OBJECTIONS TO THE INSURANCE COMMISSIONER’S MOTION, THE STATE  
COURT INJUNCTION ORDER, AND  
THE NOTICE OF AMENDMENT OF PLAN**

The United States moves to dissolve the Order for Temporary Supplemental Injunctive Relief issued by State Court Judge William D. Johnston on November 8, 2010. Additionally, the United States objects to the Motion for Temporary Supplemental Injunctive Relief, Notice Of Amendment to Plan of Operation and, to the extent not addressed by our motion to dissolve, the State Court’s Order for Temporary Supplemental Injunctive Relief.

The parties have filed a joint stipulation (Dkt. # 8) identifying an agreed briefing schedule for both this pleading and the Insurance Commissioner’s anticipated motion for remand. This joint stipulation is pending before the Court.

The stipulated briefing schedule gives the United States an extra two days, until Friday,

December 17, 2010, to file our objections and defenses pursuant to Rule 81(c) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. The United States needs the time allotted in the parties' stipulation to complete its memorandum in support of this motion and objection. Because the Court has not yet signed the parties' stipulation regarding the briefing schedule, the United States is filing this motion now. We will file a substantive memorandum in support and, if necessary, amend this motion on or before Friday, December 17, 2010.
